

Notice regarding OSHA's New Recordkeeping and Reporting Requirements
Updated January 5, 2015

On September 18, OSHA published a [final rule](#) in the Federal Register revising the reporting requirements of severe injuries and updating the list of industries partially exempt from recordkeeping requirements established in 29 CFR 1904. Establishments in *federal jurisdictions* must comply with the new requirements beginning January 1, 2015. OSHA's September 18 final rule did **not** go into effect in Kentucky on January 1, 2015; [803 KAR 2:180](#) **remains in effect** in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

In 2006, Kentucky implemented reporting requirements found in [803 Kentucky Administrative Regulation \(KAR\) 2:180](#) that are similar but differ from OSHA's September 18 final rule. The Department of Workplace Standards is reviewing OSHA's September 18 final rule to determine what action may be necessary.
