

LEGAL NOTICE  
KENTUCKY LABOR CABINET

Pursuant to Kentucky Revised Statute 338.051 and 803 Kentucky Administrative Regulation 2:010, notice is hereby given. The Kentucky Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board, hereinafter referred to as Board, will meet Thursday, February 27, 2020, at 1:00 p.m. EDT in the Brown Foreman Kentucky Room at the Thomas D. Clark Center for Kentucky History, 100 West Broadway Street, Frankfort, Kentucky.

Pursuant to House Bill 50, the Board will consider amendments to 803 KAR 2:040 Definitions; 803 KAR 2:301 Adoption and extension of established federal standards; 803 KAR 2:304 Exit routes and emergency planning; 803 KAR 2:311 Fire protection; 803 KAR 2:312 Compressed gas and compressed air equipment; 803 KAR 2:315 Hand and portable powered tools and other hand-held equipment; 803 KAR 2:316 Welding, cutting, and brazing; 803 KAR 2:319 Commercial diving operations.

Pursuant to the Standards Improvement Project-Phase IV, published in the May 14, 2019 *Federal Register*, the Board will consider amendments to 803 KAR 2:300 General; 803 KAR 2:320 Toxic and hazardous substances; 803 KAR 2:400 Adoption of 29 CFR 1926.1-6; 803 KAR 2:403 Occupational health and environmental controls; 803 KAR 2:404 Personal protective and lifesaving equipment; 803 KAR 2:406 Signs, signals, and barricades; 803 KAR 2:407 Adoption of 29 CFR 1926.250-252; 803 KAR 2:418 Underground construction, caissons, cofferdams, and compressed air; 803 KAR 2:422 Rollover protective structures; overhead protection; 803 KAR 2:425 Toxic and hazardous substances; 803 and KAR 2:500 Maritime employment.
